#### **BEYOND THE PALE**

The "pale" in this idiom stems from the Latin "palus", one of the stakes driven into the ground to designate a boundary. For example "pale" fences were built all over Europe beginning in the Roman era to designate territory belonging to a particular nation. By the 14<sup>th</sup> century, a pale had come to mean a territory, as in the 15<sup>th</sup> century "English Pale" portion of Ireland that England controlled. The meaning eventually changed, partly as a result of Rudyard Kipling's story "Beyond the Pale" (1888). The pale became a place to which
