Order of Australia Honours

The system of Australian honours was established in 1975. It replaced the previous Imperial system of British honours that commenced in 1901 and was phased out by the late 1980s. The highest honour the Order of Australia is to recognize service to the nation or humanity.

Australian honours are unique in that they were designed for the community to make nominations. The Australian honours system is free of patronage or political influence. Anyone can nominate an Australian citizen for an honour, with a total of 58 awards.

The Order Of Australia Medal

The design of the Medal of the Order of Australia is a badge with a gold plated silver insignia of the Order in the center. The central insignia is inscribed with the word "Australia" in gold letters. The circle also contains two gold sprigs of mimosa (wattle). The insignia is ensigned with the Crown of St Edward. The medal is hung from the ribbon of the Order. It is royal blue with a central band of mimosa blossoms.
