The Jester

A court jester, jester or fool was historically an entertainer during the medieval and Renaissance eras who was a member of the household of a nobleman or a monarch, and was employed to entertain the court and guests.

After the Restoration, Charles the Second did not reinstate the tradition of the British court jester, instead patronizing the theatre.

The last British nobles to keep jesters were the Queen Mother's family, the Bowes-Lyons. Curiously, Tonga was the first royal court to appoint a court jester in the 20th Century, the jester JD Bogdanoff (who was later embroiled in financial scandal).
