### Did you know....

The Hundred Years War was a series of conflicts in Western Europe from 1337 to 1453, waged between the House of Plantagenet and its cadet House of Lancaster, rulers of the Kingdom of England the House of Valois over the right to rule the Kingdom of France. Famous battles included the battle of Crecy in 1346 and the battle of Agincourt in 1415, which was a major English victory over the French.



The inventor of the black box or flight data recorder in planes was Australian David Ronald Warren (1925- 2010). He was buried in a casket bearing the label "Flight Recorder Inventor. Do Not Open".
