We have some new babies at Hester

It is with great pleasure that we would like to announce the birth of three wee baby birds...

The parents chose to make their nest in a potted tree on one of the apartment balconies facing Chatham Road.



This is a family of **native** Myna (or Noisy Myna) bird, unlike the **common** Myna that is a brown bird of about the same size, with a black head, and is an introduced species. Both are extremely territorial and this is the second time the birds have built their nest in this location, although this is the first time babies have been born.
