Some Changes To The Visitor Sign In Registration At Hester Canterbury.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES-

Visitors are **no longer** required to manually sign in to the Sign In book at Hester Canterbury reception desk.

All visitors can now register via their mobile phone by following the simple directions on the *"CHECK IN NOW"* form available at the entrance of the building, in the airlock at the front entrance or by every lift entry in the basement.

All visitors must simply do the following-

1/- Use your phone to scan the code,

2/- Enter your first name and phone number, and

3/- Look for the "tick", and you are now checked in.

If you can't scan in for some reason download the Service Victoria app or visit go.vic.gov.au/check-in open the app and enter **9GL NPG**.
