May 20th 1929.

The first ever Academy Awards of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences Awards were handed out at a banquet held at the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel.

“Wings” was the first film to win the award for best picture.



May 21st 1932.



Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean, she landed in Northern Ireland about 15 hours after leaving Newfoundland.

Amelia disappeared while flying over the central Pacific Ocean on July 2 1937.

May 22nd 1992.

John Carson’s final appearance as host of “The Tonight Show” after 30 seasons, (between October 1962 and May 1992).

May 23 1951.

China formally annexed Tibet as an autonomous region, giving rise to a Tibetan independence movement – led by the Dalai Lama, winner of the 1989 Nobel Peace Prize.
