## Some Changes to the COVID Restrictions

As of 11.59pm Thursday 18 November the new state wide settings are as follows-

- There are no limits on the number of people you can have in your home or in public places,
- If you are fully vaccinated you can attend hospitality venues, sporting and recreational facilities, swimming pools and sporting events,
- Residents at Faversham House may have up to 5 visitors a day,
- Masks are required indoors in limited settings including Aged Care settings. Whilst not compulsory it is strongly recommended that as best practice all residents continue wear face masks in all common areas.

### **Hester Christmas Party Friday 10 December**


