#### Some Important Information Concerning The Upcoming Election on Saturday May 21 2022

Unfortunately this year due to the current COVID environment the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) is unable to provide face-to-face mobile polling services at Faversham House for the upcoming Federal Election.

All Hester Canterbury residents have the following four options:

- If you meet the eligibility criteria, you can register now to become a *General Postal Voter.* This means you will receive a postal vote once ballot papers are available from April 26 *(applications close 18 May 2022).*
- Residents can *apply for a once-off postal vote (applications close 18 May 2022).*
- Residents can *visit a pre-poll voting centre.*
- Residents can visit a polling place on election day (Saturday 21 May 2022).
