If you require any assistance with meals of anything else please call Hester Canterbury's main number on 8809 0300 and one of the staff will try to assist as best they can.

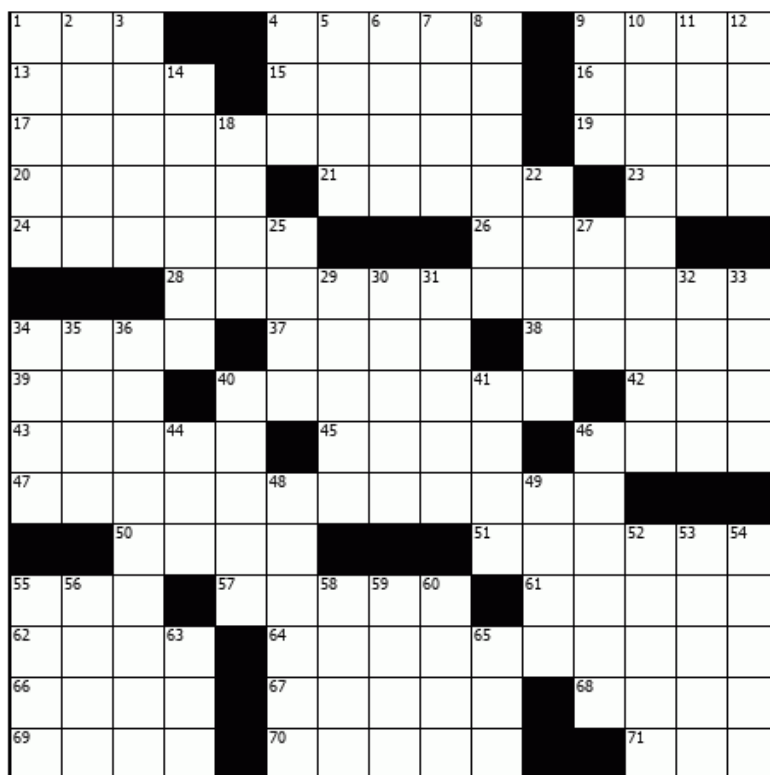
