Each apartment has been fitted with a **Tunstall Alarm System** base station and access to a press button pendant that you can have on your person, that once activated goes directly to an operator who will manage the situation, even if

the system? In certain situations, having the **Tunstall** system at reach could literally be the difference between life and death and having seen the system in action in recent times, I can assure you there is probably no better peace of mind.
