COMING SOON TO A SUN NEAR YOU!



Let there be light and there will be, naturally. **Energy Aware** have advised that they can potentially commence the installation of **Hester Canterbury's Solar Panels** next **Monday 14 November at 8am**. The initial set-up and install of the panels should take them roughly 2 days to complete, with an additional 2 - 3 days to wire it into our mains.

A crane will be required on Monday to get all the infrastructure and equipment onto the roof and the only location to position this is the driveway to the carpark, so there will be no access to and from between roughly **9am and 1pm**, however this is still to be advised. Though **Energy Aware** are doing everything possible to limit the disruption to the community, there will be some nice pollution in the initial stages of the project for those on the higher floors.
