My mother's cook-book from the depression year of 1933 (New Standard Cookery – Illustrated) contained a section entitled "**The Australian Kitchen**". This set out recipes for cooking all manner of endangered species, like bandicoot, but as these can be hard to find and noting how the sports reserve opposite is regularly invaded by cockies, galahs and corellas to name a few, the following might add spice to any **Australia Day BBQ**!

Port Adelaide Pie	
12 Paraquets	4 rashers Bacon
6 thin slices Pork or Beef.	4 teaspoonful minced Parsley
Salt and Pepper	3 hard-boiled Eggs
Pinch of crushed Herbs.	1/4 lb. peeled Mushrooms if

A LOUNGE WORTHY OF YOUR HOME



Thank you to the residents who provided feedback regarding the Club Lounge and Dining Room communal areas. The general consensus was that overall the areas were aesthetically pleasing, comfortable and mostly practicable, with a few minor tweaks required. Suggestions were put forward to create more personal spaces within the Club Lounge than the present open plan, so I propose a trial layout (as shown on the left) and ask for your feedback.

The main concern was around the present armchairs in the Club Lounge being uncomfortable and too cumbersome to relocate, plus the main table pedestal in the Dining Room has raised many an issue. We are very open to discussion around replacing or adding furniture however it goes without saying that this would be an expensive exercise and you would need to take into consideration that there has already been considerable expenditure of the long term maintenance fund to date.

In the interim we will look at further enhancing the

spaces in a practical way and happy to trial different layouts to breathe new life into the communal areas.
