### HIGH TIME FOR SOMETHING SPECIAL

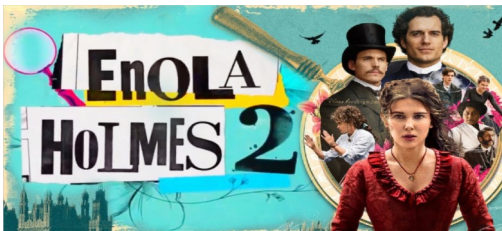

### GRIME AND SLIME ARE A CRIME

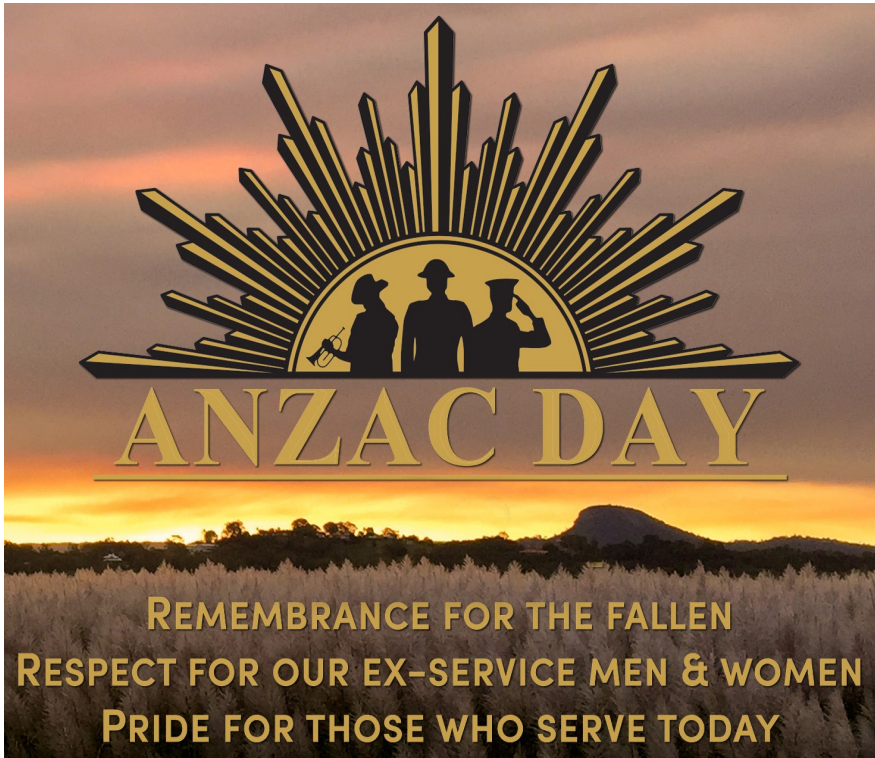
