POWER TO THE PEOPLE

As part of the final install of the back-up **Generator Infrastructure**, contractors will be performing a full test of the system on **Wednesday 28 June from 9am**. This will include positioning a portable generator in the Faversham House car park along the west wing side and a planned **30 minute shut down** of all power to the Hester Canterbury **Basement Car Park**. We will ensure that the car park gate is in the open position prior to the shutdown, however, if you do need to navigate the basement car park during the power outage, please take extreme caution and let me know if you require any assistance.
