PRIZE PAINTINGS ON THE PENISULA

Open to Australian and New Zealand artists, the portraits encapsulate an individual distinguished in Art, Letters, Science or Politics and has witnessed its fare share of controversy over the years. This years Archibald Prize exhibition will be held at the Mornington Peninsula Regional Gallery between

15 September and 5 November, 2023.
