THE ROAD TO SUCCESS IS ALWAYS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

As you may be aware, **Boroondara Council** recently invited feedback on 2 options for improvements to **Maling Road** precinct. They received 836 survey responses from the community and local business, including 21 traders. They also received 23 written submissions, with both street upgrade options receiving significant support. The community survey focused on, traffic implications, parking considerations, public space and pedestrian safety benefits.





Though the traders voted for Option 2 and staying with two way traffic, on **11 September** at the Service Delegated Committee Meeting, councilors decided to progress with **Option 1** with a 5-3 vote.

Option 1 would create a new one-way section on Maling Road from Canterbury Road to Bryson street. It is said that this option would improve safety to the area by, reducing the amount of traffic, slowing traffic possibly through pavement treatments and reducing speed limits. In addition, creating new raised pedestrian crossings while invigorating the area through developing new public space for greenery, public seating and outdoor dining, and redesigning the entrance from Canterbury Road for new seating areas.

However, don't grab your purse or wallet just yet as it may be 3-5 years away.
